This is a shopping list of supplies your dancer will need to have for the 2014 Nutcracker season. If you start buying a little at a time now...it will be easier to find and you won't have to go to more stores than necessary at Christmas time.....

Bobby-pins	
Hair Spray (strong hold)	
Hair Nets – matching dancers' hair color (required)Walgreen's has them in 3-pack	
Make-up – listed in the Nutcracker Survival Guide listed for each part	
Black ballet slippers - if your dancer is either a child at party, Fritz, soldier, party boy, mouse or Trepak.	
Pointe shoes – 2 new pairs just in case (I can guarantee that your dancer wi tell you a week before that their shoes are dead…be prepared have them sewn too!)	11
Knot Keepers – for those dancers on pointe, pointe shoes ribbons MUST be sewn or they MUST use Knot Keepers to keep the ribbons in place while dancing. If you order them earlyyou can get them from Discount Danc for half the price.	,
Tights – Ballet Pink – 2 <u>new</u> pairsone to dance in and one just in case the first pair get a hole. (Capezio or Danskin <u>no seams!)</u>	е
Curling Iron – necessary to create the curls for any dancer who is either a little girl at the party or one of Clara's friends. (If you already have one check to see that it works.)
