

2017 NUTCRACKER - Shopping Check List

This is a shopping list of supplies your dancer will need to have for the 2016 Nutcracker season. If you start buying a little at a time now...it will be easier to find and you won't have to go to more stores than necessary at Christmas time.....

___ Bobby-pins

___ Hair Spray (strong hold)

___ Hair Nets – matching dancers' hair color (required)...Walgreen's has them in 3-pack

___ Make-up – listed in the Nutcracker Survival Guide listed for each part

___ Black ballet slippers - if your dancer is either a child at party, Fritz, soldier, party boy, mouse or Trepak.

___ Pointe shoes – 2 new pairs just in case (I can guarantee that your dancer will tell you a week before that their shoes are dead...be prepared have them sewn too!)

___ Knot Keepers – for those dancers on pointe, pointe shoes ribbons MUST be sewn or they MUST use Knot Keepers to keep the ribbons in place while dancing. If you order them early...you can get them from Discount Dance for half the price.

___ Tights – Ballet Pink – 2 new pairs...one to dance in and one just in case the first pair get a hole. (Capezio or Danskin -- no seams!)

___ Curling Iron – necessary to create the curls for any dancer who is either a little girl at the party or one of Clara's friends. (If you already have one check to see that it works.)

If you are prepared, this Nutcracker season will be less stressful and more fun! Any questions...just ask, someone will know the answer.
